## SUPPORT YOUR CHILD TO FEEL HEARD

5 Top Tips for Parents & Carers to Encourage a Child's Voice!



TIP #2:

Validate Feelings:

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I can see that you are feeling

\*insert identified feeling\*

how can I help?

TIP #3:

Ways to use my body to show I am listening:





nodding

eye contact



facing my body towards them signal & encourage praise

TIP Things I can do to #4: show I am listening:



#### repeat

Repeat what your child has told you to check for understanding.



#### clarify

Ask for clarification if you are not understanding what they are trying to say.



#### open-ended questions

Ask open-ended over closed questions to encourage discussion and to show interest.



#### summarise

Summarise at the end of the conversation what has been discussed so your child feels listened to.

## TIP Things I can say to show I am listening:

That makes me wonder about...

I can see that...

Could you tell me more about...

I agree/disagree with you because...

I noticed that...

This reminds me of... do you agree?

What do you mean by...

\*summarise\*,
Have I understood
this correctly?

What I heard you say was...

I understand.
It must be really tricky!
